October Financial Report

The current general cash reserve at 10/31/17 (which do not include Temporarily Restricted Funds or Memorial and Trust Funds) was \$166k. This is 43% of the operating budget; comfortably exceeding a good guideline for cash reserves of at least 30% of the operating budget.

Offerings through 10/31/17 are \$97k. This meets our planned monthly budget of \$24k per month and exceeds our prior year giving through 10/31 by \$3k. The total revenue through 10/31/17 is \$128k.

We are 33% through the year. Our total expense is at 25% of the full year budget. The largest expense line of Personnel is under budget at 24% of the full year budget - this is mostly due to the continuing unfilled CAT Director position. The Council and a task force formed for this purpose are working on this important issue. Facilities is also a large budget item that is under budget at 25% of the full year budget. This is mostly due to large projects (parking lot resurface and back lot) that have not yet started.

Opening Doors of Interfaith Understanding

The next meeting will be **December 11, 2017, 7:30 p.m**. We will meet for the first time at **Nativity of Our Lady Parish, 221 Daly Avenue, San Luis Obispo**.

Rabbi Linda Bertenthal will lead a discussion of *Moral Grandeur and Spiritual Audacity* by Abraham Joshua Heschel. She will focus on the following essays: "To Be a Jew: What is it?"; "No Time for Neutrality"; "The Reasons for My Involvement in the Peace Movement"; "No Religion is an Island."

In addition, Dr. Hisham Assal discuss the **meaning and significance** of the Muslim New Year celebration.

Begin the new church year beginning December 3 (Advent 1) with a copy of my *Postils*, *Year B*. Use it for you own personal weekly devotion or as a Christmas gift for family and friends (especially pastors!). (A few copies of Year C and A are also still available. Bob & Wendy Meier-


Bob and Wendy moved from Los Angeles to Arroyo Grande a year ago after falling in love with the area while on vacation in 2013.

Bob is retired from a career in business and Wendy is a psychologist with an office in Nipomo. We love exploring the area and its wineries.




Rachel Mann-
