Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

WOW! The last few weeks are still a blur to many of us with so many things happening. Deb Prieto, our Turning West consultant spent Friday, November 2nd and Saturday, November 3rd, 2018 with many various members of Mt. Carmel's congregation, leading us through vital work of communicating with each other and healing deep wounds. Here's a recap.

Friday, November 2nd - Deb met with our long-term supply pastors, Pr. John Rollefson and Pr. Richard Rollefson, to introduce herself and seek their input. After that, Deb briefly met with your Executive Team to cement the weekend's events and answer any questions.

On Friday night, Nov. 2nd all of the assembled congregation members met with Deb Prieto in the Sanctuary. (All Mt. Carmel congregation members had been invited to this congregational gathering.) Most importantly, Deb created an interactive opportunity for all congregants to give their input into the subsequent work of the 'work teams' that met on Saturday, Nov. 3rd. Deb crafted 3 different activities each with the purpose of allowing Mt. Carmel congregation members to provide their input and feedback about values, positive and negative norms, and possible community building activities.

Your Council met with Deb on Saturday, Nov. 3rd for 4 hours to begin working on the Mt. Carmel Lutheran Church strategic plan. The values identified by the members on Friday night were used as the foundation for identifying our collective values. Council discussed, consolidated and refined the top values, which were identified by all of the congregation members who assembled on Friday night Nov. 2nd. Next steps are for these values to be specifically defined and then returned to you, the members for verification. Your Council met again on Nov. 13th, with Deb Prieto via video conferencing to continue our work.

Community Building Team (See attached list) -

Saturday, Nov. 3rd, Deb met with the Community Building Team. This group of fellowship event planners identified 3 opportunities, taken from the charts the assembled congregation members created on Friday night, Nov. 2nd, for us to come together and have some FUN. The first opportunity for this multi-generational fun experience is on the first Sunday of Advent, Dec. 2nd right after church, where we will come together to make Advent wreaths! Pizza, popcorn and a movie are also part of the Dec. 2nd festivities.

Other fun the Community Building Team has in the works, a Sunday football and fellowship party at Marshall Pihl's house on Dec. 16th and a wine tasting event at the Priddy's home, likely in January. More details to come!

Last but not least, the Norms Team (see attached list) met with Deb Prieto for 3 hours on Nov. 3rd and has begun the very challenging work of refining the positive and negative norms that were identified on Nov. 2nd by all of the assembled congregation members. Some very positive and important conversations, critical to this work, began on Friday, Nov. 2nd and were further developed on Saturday, Nov 3rd. The Norms Team met again on November 15th, with Deb via videoconferencing, for another work session. The Norms Team meets again on Saturday, December 8th to continue their work. Much more to come!

The next congregation gathering with Deb Prieto of Turning West is scheduled on Saturday, Jan 12th from 9:00 - 11:30 am in the sanctuary. Please mark the date on your calendars and plan to join us. Your input is very important! Some congregation members gave us their feedback that having all congregation gatherings on Friday night disenfranchises some of our members. In recognizing the need to meet a variety of needs of the congregation members, we will offer the congregation gatherings at a variety of times, to positively impact the most members.

Thank you all for your loving prayers! We are thankful for the many blessings that God shines upon us.


