

# February 2020

In the movement of the church calendar, the liturgical season between Christmas and Lent is called "Epiphany" – a word that means "manifestation," "disclosure" or "revelation." The season of Epiphany charts the progressive manifestation and disclosure of the child born in a Bethlehem stable as the revelation of God. Beginning with the story of Wise men from the east following a star the story continues with Jesus calling his disciples and his ministry of healing and hope. As the term "epiphany" connotes, Jesus is the manifestation, the disclosure, the revelation of God's love for all the world.

The season of Epiphany is also sometimes called "ordinary time." The actual liturgical meaning of the term "ordinary" is that the Sundays after Epiphany (January 6) are numbered, as in "the first Sunday after Epiphany," "the second Sunday after Epiphany," and so on. But the term "ordinary" can also be a reminder of the deepest truth of the Christian message: that the child of Christmas, "Immanuel" is the revelation of the God who has entered into our ordinary world, the God who is with us in the ordinary day to day events of our lives.

Truth is, in light of the birth of Immanuel, no time or place is ordinary anymore. The story of God entering into our world means that all of creation is made holy and that all time is extraordinary.




