In the old parlance of the church year, the Sunday's over the course of summer were called the numbered as "Sundays after Trinity." I'm not sure why there was a change in terminology to the Sundays after Pentecost, but although sometimes seeming obscure or esoteric in the history of theology, the importance of the concept of the Trinity for the Christian faith remains.

As the poem above suggests, the idea of the Trinity is not just an abstract doctrine but an articulation of the triune presence and compassion of God – above us, beside us, beneath us. What the doctrine of the trinity attempts to bring to language is the experience of God's grace – as Creator, Christ and Spirit. What we celebrate throughout the summer on the Sundays after Trinity / Pentecost) is the God whose love surrounds us always: in the wonder of creation, in the healing compassion of Christ and in the empowering presence of the Spirit.


